ESE awareness campaign on Antibiotics in Endodontics

The ESE has written to the Officers and ESE country representatives of all full member national Endodontic societies and their members, individual members of the ESE and dental schools in countries affiliated with the ESE to promote the ESE awareness campaign on use of antibiotics in Endodontics.

The ESE is hoping that all national societies will develop inclusive, effective and dynamic national awareness campaigns that will reach out to all dental professionals, other healthcare professionals (including doctors), other national dental/medical societies and the public.

The key feature of the ESE campaign is to emphasise the appropriate use of antibiotics for endodontic conditions and the need to place more emphasis on local dental/endodontic treatment. In particular, the ESE wishes to emphasise the risks associated with the inappropriate use of antibiotics and the crisis of antibiotic resistance.
