

**New President of the Canadian Academy of Endodontics

Dr. Manjinder Lalh is a certified specialist in Endodontics practicing in Edmonton, Alberta, Canada. Dr. Lalh graduated as a general dentist from the University of Alberta in 1990. In 2010, Dr. Lalh completed a Business in Dentistry Certificate Program at the University of Alberta. In September, the University of Toronto presented Dr. Lalh an Arbor Award for outstanding volunteer service to the University of Toronto.

Currently, he is the President of the Canadian Academy of Endodontics and also the current President of the Alberta Society of Endodontists. He is an active member of the Canadian Academy of Endodontics and the American Association of Endodontists.

Dr. Lalh maintains a full time specialty practice in Edmonton, Alberta. He conducts continuing education seminars in endodontics for clinicians in Canada and internationally. Dr. Lalh is a guest lecturer at the University of Alberta, and University of Toronto.
