



Former President of the ESE, Gunnar Bergenholtz, was awarded Honorary Member status of the ESE following an unanimous vote in favour of the proposition at the General Assembly in Rome. Gunnar was President of the ESE from 2001 to 2009 and led the transformation of the ESE from a society of individual 'active' members to the present position in which the ESE consists of 31 Member Societies from 28 countries, with over 6000 individual members and more than 230 Certified and Guest Members.
