The Executive Board are delighted to announce the adoption of a refreshed Constitution & Bylaws.

The new ESE Constitution & Bylaws includes:

- Revised purpose, mission and aims/objectives;
- A new set of Society values and aspirations;
- The creation of a new ongoing Chief Operating Officer position to replace the Interim CEO position;
- The creation of a new Benefits of Endodontics Committee with the Chair becoming a member of the Executive Board;
- The creation of a President Elect position, with the individual becoming a member of the Executive Board;
- The election of representatives of the individual members to the General Assembly.

PURPOSE

The purpose of the Society is to be an organisation with global reach and impact focused on the broad field of Endodontology, the branch of dental sciences dealing with health, injuries to and diseases of the dental pulp and periradicular region, and their relationship with general health and wellbeing.
