

New Chair of the ESE Research Committee

The Executive Board are delighted to announce that Kerstin Galler will take over as Chair of the ESE Research Committee from Leo Tjäderhane on 1 April 2020.



Kerstin Galler is an Associate Professor, Deputy Department Chair and Section Leader "Endodontology and Dental Traumatology", Department of Conservative Dentistry and Periodontology at the University Hospital Regensburg, Germany. Her time is divided between clinical work with a focus on Endodontology and Conservative Dentistry, teaching as a senior lecturer and clinical instructor, and research. Her research group works on pulp biology and particularly on tunable scaffolds, dental stem cells and dentine matrix proteins for dental pulp tissue engineering and regenerative endodontics. Kerstin was awarded her Habilitation from the University of Regensburg in 2011 and a PhD in Biomedical Engineering from Rice University, Houston, TX, USA in 2009.

Dr. Galler was President of the Pulp Biology and Regeneration Group of IADR in 2013/14 and led the development of the ESE Position Statement on Revitalization. She has been involved in national and international committees on vital pulp treatment and published in the field of pulp biology and dental pulp tissue engineering. Kerstin has also received several awards for her scientific work and has lectured extensively nationally and internationally in clinical as well as scientific meetings.
