

## Young Investigator Research Grant 2018 awarded to Greig D Taylor, Newcastle, UK

The European Society of Endodontology (ESE) awards young researcher grants to support young investigators in the early phase of their research career in Endodontology ("young" investigator in the context of this award is defined as an individual who is 'professionally' young in academic terms rather than in chronological age, e.g. pre-doctoral students at all levels (MSc, PhD students and equivalent), and up to 3 years following the award of a PhD (or equivalent).



### Summary of project

A sequential mixed-methods study will be used to explore the knowledge and attitudes of general dental practitioners (GDPs) regarding their management of traumatic dental injuries in the permanent dentition in 7-16 year-olds. There are two phases to this study. Phase I will involve a cross-sectional analysis of GDPs knowledge, attitudes and perceived barriers in the treatment of dental trauma as well as the awareness of evidence based trauma management tools and the specific training need of GDPs in trauma management. Phase II will see three GDP focus groups to further develop the ideas and concepts obtained from Phase I. A separate focus group, involving paediatric dental specialists only, will be carried out to identify the pertinent links that are required between primary and secondary care facilities in the management of dental trauma. It is hoped this research will address the lack of evidence and bridge the gap between primary and secondary care with the overall intention of improving the long-term outcomes for children who sustain a traumatic dental injury.
